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AMENDMENT TO EASEMENT

TO USE WATER FROM SPRING

WHEREAS,

by a document entitled "EASEMENT TO USE WATER FROM SPRING" recorded in Lincoln County on JANUARY 18, 1963, Rook 231, Page 130, GLENN E. PAULSON and INA LOUISE PAULSON and ROY SJOSTROM and DOROTHY SJOSTROM granted to ALSEA RIVER ENTERPRISES, a California Limited Partnership, certain rights to draw and use water from a certain spring located on a parcel of land situated in Lincoln County, State of Oregon and described as follows:

That part of the South half of the West half of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 27, Township 13 South, Range 10 West of the Willamette Meridian in Lincoln County, Oregon, lying Southwesterly of the Alsea Highway right-of-way in Lincoln County, Oregon.
